## Section 40 Certificate Checklist

A Section 40 Certificate is required to be obtained from Local Authority under the Liquor Licensing Act to confirm the sale of Liquor is in accordance with the Local Planning Scheme, an approved use or existing planning approval from Local Council.

The following information is required to be submitted for Council to determine if a Certificate may be issued.

A Section 39 Certificate may also be required, this is a separate application submitted to Council's Environmental Health Department. Please check with Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor for instruction on the Certificates that are required for your specific premises.

Applications containing insufficient information significantly increase processing times and delay all applications. Priority is given to processing complete applications. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED.**
