# **ROADS AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE**

---

### **Objective**

To build and maintain the best quality roads, streets, drainage system, paths and associated infrastructure within available financial constraints.

### **Policy**

In the provision of non-building infrastructure, the following factors shall be ensured:

- a) All applicable standards and industry quality provisions are met or exceeded.
- b) The maintenance and maximisation of the asset life of all infrastructure is undertaken in a timely and cost effective manner to the limit of available budgetary provisions.
- c) That staff will pursue and adopt the most modern and effective machinery, techniques, materials, technology and processes available to achieve the highest quality construction, maintenance and administration of all such infrastructure. The protection of the environment into and over which infrastructure assets are built and maintained, to ensure any negative impacts are minimised, repaired and enhanced where possible, while still accepting the obligation to use land set aside for infrastructure provision for that purpose.
- d) Safety is of paramount importance in construction of roads and associated infrastructure.
