ORGANISATIONS AND CLUBS USING COUNCIL PLANT

Objective

To reduce the cost to community groups undertaking enhancement works on Council owned lands or facilities.

To reduce the cost of the provision of such lands or facilities to the community as well as promoting such 'self help' from community groups.

Policy

That the Executive Manager of Infrastructure be authorised to approve of requests from groups to use Council plant on projects or land owned or controlled by Council.

Council plant will only be made available outside normal working hours and upon the strict condition that a Council employee operates the plant. Plant will only be provided when convenient and the Clubs using Council plant will be requested to pay for the cost of fuel used and pay the drivers time if he/she does not work on a voluntary basis.

The maximum use of such machinery shall be 2 weekends or 4 total days
