Position Overview

Primary functions:

The Junior Aquatic Recreation Officer (Supervised) assists in providing support to the senior lifeguard sand Customer service in the supervision of pool users and undertakes a full range of maintenance and operational tasks to ensure the standards required for pool facilities are met. Due to age restrictions, this position requires continuous supervision by senior lifeguards and Customer service until the age of 16.

Continuous Supervision: This position requires continuous supervision by senior lifeguards until the age of 16, in accordance with safety regulations and best practices.

Customer Service and Front Counter: Provide customer service and manage front counter tasks as needed.

Maintenance and Operational Support:	
Routine Maintenance: Help with routine maintenance tasks such as cleaning, vacuuming, and chemical testing as directed by senior staff.
