### Works updates

Courtney Road - upgrade to lower order roads - works on Courtney Road that have been completed to date include repair of rutts, shoulder grading, re-sweep and painting. The resal will take place in the new year, as warmer overnight temperatures are required.

Wallcliffe Road dual use pathway - Renewal pathways to be carried out from Deane Drive heading East, will commence late October, early November. Message boards are currently in place and alternate pedestrian access will be provided during this time.

Marnup Road - Shouldering works are currently being carried out on Marnup Road from Memorial Drive to the creek. These are works funded by the Shire.

Warner Glen Road - reconstruction works, in accordance with section 3.50 of the Local Government Act 1995. Part 3 functions of Local Governments - Closing certain thoroughfares to vehicles currently underway. Funded by Regional Road Groups (Main Roads). Traffic management will be in place, so please follow the traffic controllers directions and drive to the set speeds.

Ellerbrook Road - re-shouldering, in accordance with section 3.50 of the Local Government Act 1995, Part 3 functions of Local Governments - Closing certain thoroughfares to vehicles, from Cave Road to Garstone Road. During these works traffic management will be in place, the Shire will endeavour to avoid lengthy delays, however where an alternative route is possible, please consider this. The Shire appreciates your patience during these works.

Please note: During any road works, it is likely traffic management will be in place, the Shire will endeavour to avoid lengthy delays, however where an alternative route is possible, please consider this. The Shire appreciates your patience during works locations that require Traffic Management. Safety is the Shire's number one priority.

### Notice of Planned Hazard Reduction Burn

Fire Agencies (Shire of Augusta-Margaret River, Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions, Department of Fire and Emergency Services) will, in the coming weeks, commence important planned burning activities. These planned burns are critical for reducing fuel loads surrounding town areas in order to reduce impact of wild fires on homes and other infrastructure should they occur.

Hazard Reduction Burns are planned burns to be completed in and around Margaret River Shire Reserve 18720. This will necessitate the need to close the Warden Track adjacent to Railway Terrace for a period of time.

The production of smoke can have impacts on the health of some people which can be reduced by:

- Removing yourself from the area (val friends and family in other areas)
- Close windows, doors and turn off air conditioning
- Bring in washing
- Plan not to drive during the burn, or if driving turn car air conditioning to recirculate
- Reduce speeds and follow traffic instructions
- Avoid the area
