Why we are collecting your information

We collect this information for the following purposes:

- managing animal ownership, registration and identification
- administering kennel licences and approvals for prescribed numbers of dogs
- investigating complaints and enquiries relating to animals and livestock
- managing the impounding of animals and livestock

Where your information will be stored

Your information is held in the Shire's enterprise resource planning and records management systems.

How your information may be disclosed

Your personal information may be used and disclosed for the purposes outlined above.

The Shire may disclose personal information to:

- authorised Shire officers in relevant service areas
- State Government agencies (e.g. Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development)
- State Government statutory authorities
- Local Government authorities
- microchip registries and database providers (e.g. Central Animal Records (CAR), Global Micro, Australasian Animal Registry (AAR))

- veterinarians and animal rescue organisations

Information may also be disclosed where authorised or required by law.

How we're authorised to collect your information

We collect, use and disclose your personal information in accordance with applicable laws, including:

- Cat Act 2011
- Dog Act 1976
- Dogs Local Law 2017

Consequences of not providing information

If you choose not to provide the required information, the Shire may be unable to:

- process animal registrations or licences
- identify animal ownership
- investigate complaints or incidents
- proceed with ranger investigations
- take appropriate compliance or enforcement action
