**The following documents will need to be submitted before a permit application can be assessed and processed.**

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1. This application form completed and signed by the applicant.

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2. Scale Site plan - applications must be accompanied by a too scale site plan this should include the location of the current pump and pipe, and the location on private land where the pump is to be relocated. All pumps will need to be removed from Shire land due to fire safety and noise impacts

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**3. Photographs** of all infrastructure located within the Shire reserve

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3. A current public liability insurance policy for at least \$20,000,000 that will cover this infrastructure

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4. Application fee

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#### **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT BY APPLICANTS**

It will be a condition of all approvals that a current public liability insurance policy is in place.

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If the proposed infrastructure also cross UCL (Unallocated Crown Land), you will also require a Section 91 permit from the Department of Planning Lands and Heritage. (A copy of this permit should be submitted to the Shire once received for record keeping purposes).

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If your infrastructure crosses UCL you will not have a Riparian Right under the Rights In Water and Irrigation Act and will also require a Water Licence from the Department of Water. (A copy of this permit should be submitted to the Shire once received).

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If any of the land on which the infrastructure is located is an Aboriginal Site under the Aboriginal Heritage Act you may need additional approval from the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs before being issued your Local Law Permit. The Aboriginal Heritage Inquiry System can be accessed via the Department of Planning Lands and Heritage Website to determine if it applies.

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All existing pumps on Shire managed reserves will need to be relocated to private property prior to a permit for infrastructure being issued. The permit will only be issued for pipes, filters and alike.

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This permit does not provide any additional protection to the infrastructure located on the Shire reserve if damaged through Shire maintenance works. If you are concerned that your equipment may be damaged it is recommended that you seek appropriate insurance cover.

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Permits are valid for a period of five years, after which time you will be required to reapply.
