

Fire Season Information Sheet



September 2020

Campfires, Fire Pits, BBQs and Pizza Ovens

Campfires and fire pits are NOT permitted at any time during the PROHIBITED Burning Period from 23 December to 14 March (Please note: these dates are subject to change according to conditions).

During the **Restricted Burning Periods** (9 November to 22 December & 15 March to 12 May) please observe the following requirements in relation to campfires and fire pits. Use of wood and solid fuel BBQs and wood fired pizza ovens* are permitted during the Restricted and Prohibited Burning Periods in accordance with the table below.

TOTAL FIRE BAN	Not Permitted	Not Permitted

SEVERE	Not Permitted	Not Permitted
VERY HIGH	Not Permitted	Not Permitted
HIGH	Permitted after 6pm - must be extinguished by 11pm	Permitted
LOW - MODERATE	Permitted after 6pm - must be extinguished by 11pm	Permitted

Please Note: Campfires are NOT permitted on public land unless purpose built campfire pits have been provided by the owner of the land and permission to use them has been given (during restricted period only).
