



Shire of Augusta Margaret River Library Service FAQs: How Do I...?

Join the library

I'm a resident of the Augusta Margaret River Shire, living in a house or unit (not a hostel, caravan park or camping ground)

You are entitled to join the library, after which you may borrow items, use the wifi/PCs and access our online resources. Your membership will be valid at both the Margaret River and the Augusta branches.

Come to the Front Counter with:

- Proof of identity with photo (usually a drivers licence, student ID or passport)
- Proof of residential address within the Shire (a drivers licence, rates notice, bank statement, car registration, etc)

Our friendly staff will ask you to complete a form and will introduce you to our library service.

I am not a resident of the Augusta Margaret River Shire, but I do live in Western Australia

You are entitled to join the library, after which you may borrow items, use the wifi/PCs and access our online resources. Your membership will be valid at both the Margaret River and the Augusta branches.

Come to the Front Counter with:

- Proof of identity with photo (usually a drivers licence, student ID or passport)
- Proof of your Western Australian address (a drivers licence, rates notice, bank statement, car registration, etc)

Our friendly staff will ask you to complete a form and will introduce you to our library service.

I am living in, or passing through, the Augusta Margaret River Shire and cannot show that I am a resident of the Shire or of Western Australia

You can join the library as an *Internet member*, which will entitle you to use the wifi/PCs and our online resources. You will not be permitted to borrow items. Your membership will be valid at both the Margaret River and the Augusta branches.

Come to the Front Counter with:

- Proof of identity with photo (a drivers licence, student ID or passport – does not need to be an Australian document)

Our friendly staff will ask you to complete a form and will introduce you to our library service.

I'm not a resident of the Shire or of Western Australia, but I really want to borrow some items

In some cases, an admin fee and bond can be paid to enable non-residents to borrow - please come to the Front Counter and ask our friendly staff about this.

We also have a free paperback exchange available for those in need!
